<u>PORCELAINBERRY</u>, <u>Ampelopsis brevipedunculata</u>,

NON-NATIVE INVASIVE

Porcelainberry, also named Amur Peppervine and Wild Grape, is native to Asia. It is generally similar to, and potentially confused with, native grape species. It climbs via tendrils to a height of more than 20 feet. Flowers are small, green-white, born in umbels opposite the leaves, and project upwards: grape flowers hang down below the stems.
